Children of all abilities enjoy horse and art programs

Hands on Horses ~ June 22-26 and July 13 - 17

Ages 8 – 16 Cost: \$285.00 Time: 9 am - noon

Each day will include an unmounted theory lesson, groundwork with your horse, grooming, tack, and best of all riding! All of this will be accomplished while building a foundation of safety habits.

Equestrian Vaulting ~ July 6 - 10

Ages 6 – 18 Cost: \$205.00 Time: 9 am - noon

Growing in popularity, this equestrian sport combines dance and gymnastics performed on the back of a moving horse. Vaulting promotes balance, confidence and oneness with the horse in a safe, supportive environment.

3-D Art and Sculpture ~ June 15, 17, 19 and June 29, July 1, 3

Ages 8 – 18 Cost: \$65.00 Time: 9:30 am - noon

Combines a variety of art materials such as paper, clay, plaster, fiber and beads as well as found and recycled objects to create unique sculptures and three-dimensional art.

Painting ~ **July 13, 15, 17**
