What is Double Down for Autism? Double Down for Autism is the Autism Society of Greater Akron's Casino Night. This year is our fourth year holding this popular event. Due to COVID-19, we decided to go virtual.

When you say virtual, what do you mean? You can participate from the comfort of your own home! You'll be sent a "Party Pack" and the rest happens in Handbid, our online silent auction site. We'll also invite you to a brief program all about how your participation makes a difference in our community. We'll be connected...without being together!

What if I have been invited to a "House Party?" Board members and staff are hosting intimate "House Parties." House Party guests enjoy the same things as ticket holders. Please register on Handbid if you are attending a House Party to receive notifications, be able to bid on silent auction items, and to enter raffles.

When does everything start? October 5! #DoubleDown2020 silent auction, 50/50, and raffles open. We'll end with our live program on October 17.

What apps do I need? Download Handbid for the silent auction and for ticket holders, download Bingo Maker and join the ASGA game. More info coming soon.

- Our new <u>Social Club for Adults</u> with autism is going strong! The laughing and sharing warms our heart! This group is full and we would like to offer another group, but need resources.
- We're launching a teens and middle-school social skills group, professionally facilitated, and want to keep the cost affordable to families. This is a huge need!
- Area "chats" are sprouting up all over our service territory, including one for grandparents!
- <u>Webinars</u> continue to replace our educational workshops and we have found that even more parents and professionals can participate because they are virtual! That's great news as we help families/guardians make more informed decisions.
- Our <u>trainings</u> are also kicking back up as we are asked by community professionals to help them learn about supporting and engaging people with autism in the community.
