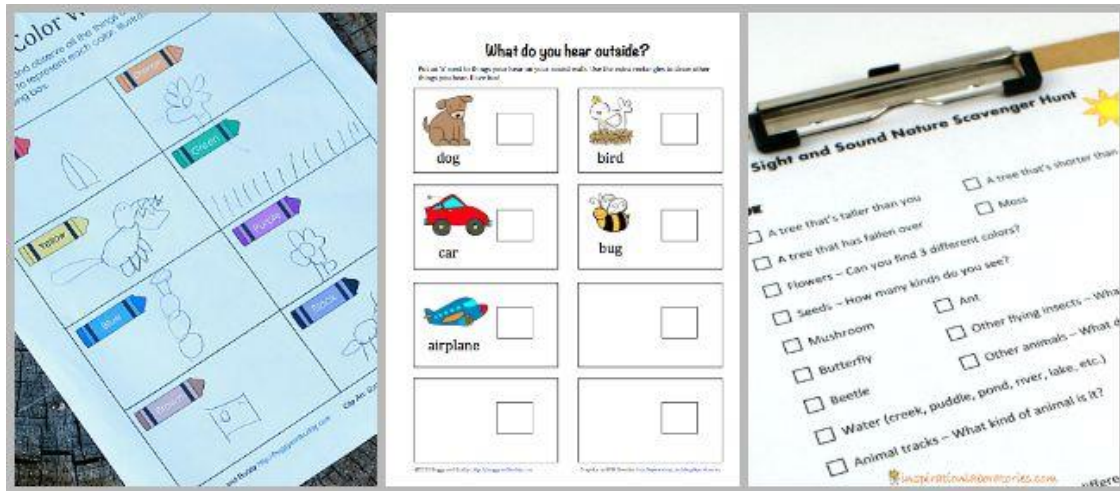


OUTDOOR SCAVENGER HUNTS
