



EGG SUNCATCHER

SUPPLIES

Contact Paper
Bright Tissue Paper
Ribbon
Sticky Tape
Scissors



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Tear bright tissue paper into strips. Make the strips as thick or thin as you like and overlap them to get a great mix of colors.
- 2. Cut out two rectangles of contact paper the same size. You'll cut these into egg shapes later so they can be any size you like. It might be fun to make a selection of egg suncatchers in different sizes.
- 3. Lay the tissue paper strips across the contact paper rectangle. You can cover the whole area, leave gaps and overlap the colors. There's no right or wrong way to do it and each egg suncatcher will be different.
- 4. Stick the second piece of contact paper over the top of the tissue paper to secure it. Then using a pencil draw on an egg shape and cut it out.
- 5. Snip a bit of ribbon and use sticky tape to fix it to the top of the egg. Now your egg suncatchers are ready for hanging up on display.
