In 1987, four in 10,000 children had a diagnosis of Autism. Children with Autism were not yet allowed to go to their local school for an education. The word "Infantile Autism" was replaced with a more expansive definition of "Autism Disorder" and a UCLA psychologist published the first study showing how intensive behavior therapy could help children with Autism – giving new hope to parents.

And in 1987, pioneering parents from Akron, OH, called the Autism Society of America and asked to start a chapter to provide support and exchange ideas of how best to advocate for their children - and the Autism Society of Greater Akron was founded. We are proud to have been on the front lines for 35 years, expanding from an all-parent network to the organization we are today.
