In 1965, Dr. Ruth Sullivan was the first elected President of the Board of the Autism Society of America (ASA). As an original founder of ASA, she was also one of the main advocates who worked to pass federal legislation allowing children with disabilities to attend public schools. I will never forget hearing Dr. Sullivan speak to a group of parents of children with Autism at an ASA conference. She told us to "never give up and never give in" and showed this picture.

She told us to pick up the baton and to keep advocating for our children – and other children – who live with Autism. As I sat with tears in my eyes listening to this amazing mom and advocate, I knew why I left my career in public relations to pick up that baton, becoming the first Executive Director of the Autism Society of Greater Akron (ASGA).

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) is a developmental disability that causes social, communication and behavioral differences. The CDC estimates that 1:36 children and more than 5.4 million adults live with Autism. People with ASD behave, communicate, interact, and learn in ways that are different from most other people. The abilities of people with ASD can vary significantly; some people with ASD need a lot of help in their daily lives; others can work and live with little to no support.

We create connections, empowering everyone in the Autism community with the resources needed to live fully.


Our Vision
